

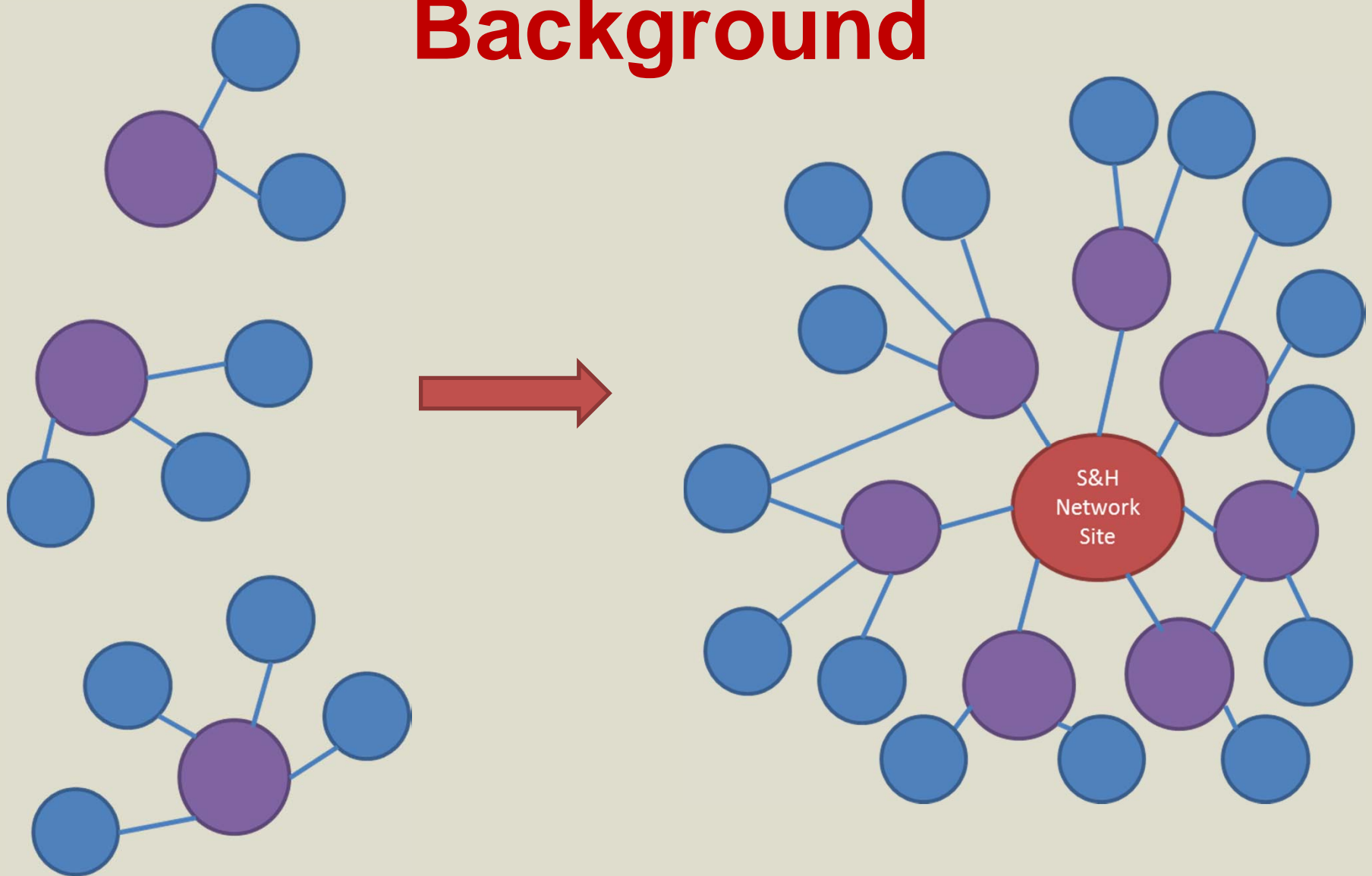

Input from 2016 r2p Seminar Attendees:

1. Time constraints

Final S&H Network Goals


Overarching Goal:
